Dear Sarah and Lori,

I am handling the proposed revision to the Bilingual-Bicultural Education Concentration for the Senate Education Policy Committee. I think this is a pretty straightforward change, but it is a little bit obscured in the CIM-P write up. So, I wanted to check my understanding with you. If you agree on my interpretation, we will append this to the proposal.

There are some changes to formatting in the proposal, but the substantive change regards the C&I EDM without licensure program. This program is a 32 hour masters program. However, as it stands (before revision) students in that program who want the BBE Concentration need 4 additional "unique" hours beyond what counts toward the EDM, bringing total hours for the C&I EDM without licensure plus the BBE Concentration to 36. The revision removes the requirement for 4 unique hours, making it possible for students to earn the EDM without licensure and BBE Concentration with only 32 hours.

Is that correct? Because the revision also involves deleting a large block of text and moving most of it into the program of study, I just wanted to make sure this is the key element.
