Brief Description:

The purpose of this revision is to terminate the Community Studies and Outreach (CSO) concentration

Justification:

In the past three years, the Department of Human and Community Development (HCD) has experienced substantial downsizing in faculty and a sharpening of the department's program focus, such that the CSO concentration cannot be maintained. The Community Studies and Outreach Concentration's course requirements no longer reflect the department's program identity or research strengths.

We have not admitted doctoral students into the CSO concentration for the past two years. The 6 CSO students who are currently working towards their doctorates have completed all of their required coursework.

Budgetary and Staff Implications:

The termination of the CSO concentration will allow the Department of HCD to more effectively utilize its resources.
