- **BRIEF DESCRIPTION:** The Department of Education Policy, Organization and Leadership wishes to terminate the Doctorate of Education (Ed.D.) option in Human Resource Education. The proposal to terminate the Ed.D. option in HRE is completely a demand issue. HRE had very few Ed.D. applicants and enrolled students each year. Currently there are only a handful of students in the degree program and all are expected to finish within the next 4 years.
- **JUSTIFICATION:** EPOL currently has 5 Ed.D. students in HRE. Since the departure of the CCEL (Community College Executive Leadership) program to EOL, we typically only have a handful every few years. The 5 registered are nearing the qualifying exam and dissertation stage and we are not accepting any new students into that degree program. Based upon these conditions and the recommendation from the Graduate College to carefully assess the need for continuing the Ed.D. option in HRE, EPOL is requesting to close/terminate the Ed.D. degree in HRE.
