BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

We are proposing to change the name of our department: Current name: Department of Human and Community Development Proposed name: Department of Human Development and Family Studies

JUSTIFICATION:

The Department of Human and Community Development represents a long tradition at Illinois and is part of a network of similar units at peer institutions across the country – all with Home Economics at their earliest roots. The Department at Illinois grew out of the School of Human Resources and Family Studies, a larger unit named in 1974 and organized (in 1978) with four divisions – Family and Consumer Economics, Food and Nutrition, Human Development and Family Ecology, and Textiles and Interior Design. The current name, Human and Community Development, came into being during the College's re-organization in 1995. At that time, the School of Human Resources and Family Studies was combined with three other entities to create the Department of Human and Community Development (HCD). Notably, Department members at that time were not participants in the name selection.

The configuration of HCD has changed considerably since the 1990s re-organization. We no longer have Rural Sociology, Community Studies, Agricultural Communications, or Agricultural Education as components. Moreover, the "Community" portion of our departmental focus has greatly diminished. Today our faculty members focus primarily on human development (e.g., child/adolescent development, youth activism, childhood health and obesity, parent-child attachment relations) and/or family studies (e.g., couple dynamics, family violence, immigrant families, father involvement). Although community as a context of development is considered important across all these areas (e.g., the impact of neighborhood on parenting), community as the unit of analysis is typically not a focal point of study. The academic major that remains in our department is Human Development and Family Studies (HDFS). Indeed, all of our

undergraduate and most of our graduate courses currently have the HDFS rubric (a few of our graduate courses are HCD – something that we are changing via a companion proposal that also requests a change in the name of our graduate degree). We believe that the time has come for our department to have a name that accurately reflects our identity: *Human Development and Family Studies*.

There are several compelling reasons for a name change to Human Development and Family Studies:

- We need a name that is a more accurate reflection of the work our faculty do (e.g., family issues and human development).
- We need a name that is consistent with our undergraduate major name (HDFS) and that is consistent with our undergraduate and graduate course rubric (HDFS).
- There is a current national dialog on the need for consistency in unit names for departments like ours. There were recently 2 panel discussions on the topic at the annual meetings of the National Council on Family Relations one of the leading organizations in our field.
- Human Development and Family Studies (HDFS) is the most common (modal) name for departments like ours in the U.S. Most of our strongest peers/competitors have HDFS as their department name (e.g., Purdue University, Pennsylvania State University, University of Wisconsin, Michigan State University, University of Texas at Austin, Auburn University).
- Department name is the primary way that interested students find a graduate program, an academic major, and courses.
- Department name provides valuable information about department identity for job candidates when positions are open.

Several benefits would accrue from a name change to Human Development and Family Studies. It would:

- Greatly improve our ability to <u>recruit graduate students</u> searching for "family" training and/or a program whose identity is connected to a national cohort.
- Enhance our ability to recruit <u>undergraduate majors</u>, especially among entering freshmen and transfer students who are seeking a foundation in family issues.
- Increase our capacity to attract excellent and fitting <u>applicants for faculty positions</u>, especially those looking for positions in a recognizable disciplinary niche.
- Improve the comprehensibility and specificity of our identity for <u>advancement and</u> <u>engagement purposes</u>, decreasing misunderstandings that our focus is on community development activities.
- Avoid confusion for UIUC students and their advisors in other majors increasing our ability to <u>attract students to our undergraduate courses</u>.

We recognize that some costs would also be associated with the name change such as those related to changes in websites, stationery, business cards, marketing materials, and description of our curriculum. That said, and after careful consideration, we strongly believe that the benefits of the name change would far outweigh any associated costs.
