Brief description of the program of study: The Creative Writing Minor offers the core of the CW Major and a flexibility that allows self-direction through Literature, Film, or other writing-related courses.

Justification: Many majors on campus, including those from colleges other than LAS, would benefit from the availability of a minor in Creative Writing, a strong but flexible program that develops students' analytical and creative skills and prepares them for work in any number of fields.

Expected enrollment in the minor: 50-75.

Admission to the minor: Students are admitted into the CW Minor by declaring it. There is no selection or admissions process.

Minor advisor: CW Minors will be advised, as all of our students are, in our Undergraduate Advising Office, by one of our two full-time advisors.

Certification of successful completion: As with all majors and minors in LAS, the CW Minor would be monitored by the student's advisor and records officer.
