

By this letter, I am requesting that you take the appropriate steps to discontinue listing the Certificate of Advanced Studies (C.A.S.) in Music Education and also the M.S. in Music Education. These programs have not been active for many years. The former has a somewhat interesting history in not having been formally approved, although it was submitted and accepted for accreditation by NASM long before my arrival on campus. The M.S. is the predecessor of the Master of Music Education (M.M.E.) in which we currently enroll students.
