## Common Parliamentary Procedures for the Urbana-Champaign Senate

### Introduction of business:

By an individual senator or group of senators (Pre-filed Resolution listed on the Senate agenda):

“I move the adoption of resolution RS.20.00” (substitute the assigned resolution number). A second is required.

By a committee (an item listed on the Senate agenda):

“On behalf of the Xxx Committee, I move the adoption of XX.20.00” (substitute the committee name and the assigned business number). No second is required.

Business not on the Senate agenda (New Business):

“I move to admit the following item as New Business” (*briefly* describe the proposed business). A second is required. If this motion is approved by the Senate, the item is effectively added to the meeting agenda. One can then move to adopt the item. A second is required. Debate may then take place on the item, but, per the Open Meetings Act, no final vote can be taken at this meeting. However, motions such as amendments or referral to committee can be made and voted on. Unless postponed or referred to a committee, the item will be placed on the agenda of the next meeting.

### To change a motion:

To edit the text of the motion:

“I move to amend the motion by changing xx to yy on line ##” (insert the desired text to be changed, and indicate the line number if the original text is numbered).

To substitute an entirely new text for the original:

“I move to substitute the following for the motion” (state the substitute motion).

It is most helpful if the text of the amendment is made available to the Clerk in writing or by email for display on the screen.

In either case, a second is required. Debate must then be confined to the wisdom of the amendment; general discussion of the main motion must await the outcome of the vote on the amendment.

There is no such thing as a “friendly amendment” which is automatically adopted if the maker of the original motion is agreeable. Use the motion to amend.

### Disposition of business:

To refer to a committee:

“I move to refer this matter to the Xxx Committee” (substitute the committee name). One can add, “with instructions to” do whatever.

Or: “I move to refer this matter to a committee selected by the Senate Executive Committee”. Instructions can be added.

A second is required. Either of these motions can be amended as to the choice of committee and/or the instructions to the committee.

To postpone the matter:

“I move to postpone this matter indefinitely.” If adopted, this effectively defeats the original main motion. A second is required.

Or: “I move to postpone the matter” to a specific future meeting or for a specific period of time. A second is required.

To lay on the table:

The motion to lay on the table is *not* appropriate for this purpose. Use one of the motions to postpone.

### To terminate discussion:

To terminate discussion of the current motion to amend or to refer to committee:

“I move to close debate on the current motion.”

To terminate discussion of the main motion as well as all pending subsidiary motions (such as to amend or to refer to committee):

“I move to close debate on the current motion and on the main motion.”

In either case, a second is required, and a 2/3 vote is necessary to close debate.

The motion to “call the previous question” is equivalent wording; it means exactly the same thing as the motion to “close debate.”

\* The "precedence" column comes into play when there are multiple motions on the floor. For example, there could be a main motion, and a motion to amend, and a motion to refer to committee. The smallest "precedence" number is the motion that gets voted on first; in this example, the numbers are 13 for the main motion, 11 for the amendment, and 10 for referral to committee. So referral gets voted on first; if it loses, then amendment; then the main motion. The main motion has the highest number, as it is always the last to be voted on.

CC.20.02 Election of the Senate Executive Committee (SEC) Chair

**BACKGROUND**

The Senate Executive Committee shall initiate and guide the work of the Senate, prepare the agenda for Senate meetings, coordinate and evaluate the activities of the Senate committees, nominate members of the Committee on Committees, provide advice annually to the Chancellor on the appointment or reappointment of the vice chancellors, provide advice annually to the President on the reappointment of the Chancellor, review Campus Budget Oversight Committee, Research Board, and Research Policy Committee nominees, and perform such other duties as the *Statutes* or Senate shall specify.

The Senate Executive Committee shall be composed of 16 members, including the Chair and a Vice-Chair, elected by ballot by and from among the membership of the Senate, and who shall be the presiding officers of the Senate Executive Committee. Nominations for Chair and Vice-Chair of the Senate Executive Committee shall be made by the Committee on Committees.

## **STATEMENTS OF INTEREST AND EXPERIENCE**

### **Robin Kar (Professor, LAW, College of Law)**

Professor Kar is a Professor of Law, with a joint appointment in Philosophy. He has a BA, in philosophy (with a minor in physics) magna cum laude (Harvard); a JD from Yale Law School; and PhD in Philosophy (University of Michigan). He clerked for the Honorable Justice Sonia Sotomayor.

As 2018-2019 Vice-Chair, Professor Kar sought to empower faculty by guiding their engagement and representation in broader campus efforts. As Chair, he would continue those efforts and work for a more effectual Senate role in shared governance.

He currently chairs the task force to reevaluate methods of handling sexual harassment by faculty. He was an integral part of the campus and system-wide task forces that developed official comments and objections to the Department of Education's proposed Title IX regulations. He has participated in the naming rights working group, among many other campus governance initiatives.

His interdisciplinary scholarship easily crosses the North/South Campus divide. Areas of expertise include the evolution of morality; the prehistory of social complexity; religious tolerance; race in the genomic age; theories of contract; history of same-sex marriage law; and the impact of the digital world on traditional systems of private ordering.

### **John Bambenek (Graduate Student, GRAD, Informatics)**

In recent years, there have been a few incidents of violations of student safety whether by sexual harassment, unwanted physical contact, or illegal video recording in a University bathroom. In each case, the response for the University was, to say the least, uninspiring. In two recent cases involving faculty members, there was no substantive penalty despite clear violations of both university policy and apparently of Illinois criminal law. Illinois cannot remain a world-class public research institution while simultaneously allowing faculty-staff misconduct and attacks against students to go without an effective disciplinary response. I have previously served on the Illinois Community College Board and Illinois Board of Higher Education.

Jeffrey Eric Jenkins, former Head of the Department of Theatre at Illinois and former Director of Theatre Studies at New York University, is a Professor of Theatre who teaches dramatic literature, theatre historiography, and criticism. Author and editor of nine books and many articles, he is a faculty senator, member of the Elections and Credentials Committee, and served as a facilitator for the Office of the Provost in the General Assembly on Student Learning Outcomes for General Education. During the current academic year, Dr. Jenkins was a featured speaker in St. Petersburg, Russia, at the 29th World Congress of the International Association of Theatre Critics. Dr. Jenkins is committed to the principles of shared governance and to growing diversity, equity, and inclusion throughout the university.
