MINUTES

A regular meeting of the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign Senate was called to order at 3:10 pm with Chancellor Robert Jones presiding and Professor Emeritus H. George Friedman, Jr. serving as Parliamentarian.

SENATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

Bettina Francis (LAS), a faculty senator and Chair of the Senate Executive Committee (SEC), thanked senators for their time and service on the Senate. Governance takes time, and shared governance takes even more time. Serving on a committee is a significant part of serving the University. There were a couple of Senate meetings this year when quorum (100 senators) was lost and no additional action could be taken by the Senate. Francis encouraged all senators to remain for the entirety of the meeting in order to complete all of the business on today's agenda.

CHANCELLOR'S REMARKS

Chancellor Jones welcomed senators to the final meeting of the 2018-2019 Senate and thanked them for their service and commitment to shared governance.

At the April 1 Senate meeting, there were some concerns about safety during the MCORE (Multimodal Corridor Enhancement) project. A recent Massmail was sent from Facilities & Services with more information about the MCORE project.

Recent media stories have generated concerns about the men's basketball program. A full review was executed by the Faculty Athletic Representatives to the Big Ten Conference (FAR) and the athletic administration. Athletic Director Josh Whitman sought advice from the Office of University Counsel and the Chancellor. An internal investigation showed that Brad Underwood coaching style was intense, but not abusive. The safety of every member of this community is taken very seriously.

Allegations of misconduct against an instructor of economics were filed and the instructor is currently on leave during the investigation. The safety and privacy of our students is paramount. Because this is a personnel matter, no additional details can be given at this time.

Jones expressed his support for establishing the Discovery Partners Institute (DPI) as a temporary instate which appears on today's agenda. DPI will have local, regional, and global impact.

Illinois received \$300 million from the Grainger Foundation of which \$100 million is in unrestricted funds. This generous gift marks the 100th anniversary of William W. Grainger graduating from Illinois.

QUESTIONS

Chancellor Jones reassured senators that the alleged corruption and grade-fixing scheme at Arizona State University would never happen at Illinois.

In response to a question about the length of the MCORE project, Chancellor Jones replied that the project is projected to be completed in the next couple of years. Construction is the price of progress.

On behalf of the Senate Committee on Educational Policy (EP), Chair Miller introduced and moved approval of proposal EP.19.55. The Discovery Partners Institute (DPI) proposal was received by EP in February 2019. Bill Sanders attended several EP meetings to answer questions and make clarifications. Sanders spoke in support of the proposal. In response to a question about the governance structure, Tolliver, Chair of the University Senates Conference (USC), noted that faculty appointments would remain at the University level in the various units and would therefore follow their unit's bylaws.
