The numbers below only show the net result of those that end up with CR/NC and does not include the total volume of requests that were processed as students changed their minds.

Net result of CR/NC students/courses:

There are 10,622 undergrads enrolled in 18,121 CR/NC seats. There are 1,095 grad students enrolled in 1,576 CR/NC seats.

Net result of PP/NP students/courses:

Undergrads – 2,409 students; 2,501 seats; Grads – 220 students; 227 seats
