MONDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2020 ZOOM WEBINAR MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign Senate was called to order at 3:10 pm with Senate Executive Committee Chair Rob Kar presiding and Professor Emeritus H. George Friedman, Jr. serving as Parliamentarian.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

10/19/20-01 Without objection, the minutes of the September 21, 2020 meeting were approved as amended.

III. PUBLIC COMMENT

No requests received.

IV. APPROVAL OF FLOOR PRIVILEGES

Professor Rob Kar (LAW), a faculty senator and Chair of the Senate Executive Committee (SEC), asked for any objections to granting the following individuals floor privileges during the discussion of EP.21.018: Kevin Pitts (Vice Provost for Undergraduate Education), Meghan Hazen (Registrar), Rebecca Smith (COVID-19 SHIELD Team), and Nigel Goldenfeld (COVID-19 SHIELD Team).

10/19/20-02 Without objection, floor privileges were granted to Pitts, Hazen, Smith, and Goldenfeld to speak during the discussion of EP.21.018.

V. SENATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE CHAIR'S REMARKS

Chair Kar reported that he recently attended the BTAA (BigTen Academic Alliance) Shared Governance Conference. Kar found that institutions that have open lines of communication between their Senate and administration have done better with their response to the COVID crisis.

Despite our relative successes in the response to COVID, we will not be able to maintain success if we do not remain vigilant. The SHIELD Team has indicated there are upcoming vulnerabilities, returning from Thanksgiving break and at the start of the spring term, that pose increased health and safety risks. Limiting travel and maintaining vigilance in upholding safety precautions are key to minimizing these risks.

Kar noted the statutory changes that will be considered by the Board of Trustees at their upcoming meeting. This package of changes comes after years of hard work by all three Senates and includes the change from campus to university and university to system, important changes to the section on Academic Freedom and Tenure, and an expanded nondiscrimination statement. VII. PROPOSALS

10/19/20-07 EP.21.018* Revision to the 2020-2021 Academic Calendar (Spring Semester)

On behalf of the Senate Committee on Educational Policy (EP), chair Moorhouse introduced and moved approval of EP.21.018. A robust discussion followed with additional information and responses from Kevin Pitts, Rebecca Smith, and Nigel Goldenfeld.

- 10/19/20-08 Faculty senator Rosenstock made a motion to amend EP.21.018 by removing all three "Day Off" no class days from the proposed spring semester calendar but keep the start date of January 25 and all other dates. Add the following note to the published calendar: 'In addition to canceling classes according to currently established policies, for the spring 2021 semester instructors may designate up to three class periods in every course they teach as non-instructional reading periods, to be chosen at their discretion, not to exceed three hours of class period time for a single course.' The motion was seconded, and discussion followed.
- 10/19/20-09 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, the motion to amend failed with 11 in favor, 108 opposed, and 9 abstentions.

Discussion on the main motion resumed.

- 10/19/20-10 Student senator Kelo (FAA) made a motion to increase the number of days off (determined in advance by the administration) from 3 days to 5 days with no assignments due on days off. The motion was seconded, and discussion followed.
- 10/19/20-11 The Senate suspended discussion of EP.21.018 at 4:10 pm to host the Annual Meeting of the Faculty (see agenda item IX. Annual Meeting of the Faculty). Once the Annual Meeting of the Faculty concluded, business resumed as follows.

Discussion on the motion to increase the number of days off from 3 days to 5 days with no assignments due on days off continued. Pitts noted that there are limits to how short the semester can be and still meet the Department of Education requirement for Title IV funding.

- 10/19/20-12 Student senator Bainbridge (ENGR) made a motion to amend the amendment by specifying the five days off as follows: February 23 and 24, March 29, and April 13 and 14. The motion was seconded, and a short discussion followed.
- 10/19/20-13 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, the motion to amend the amendment failed with 14 in favor, 110 opposed, and 8 abstentions.
- 10/19/20-14 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, the motion to amend from 3 days to 5 days failed with 35 in favor, 103 opposed, and 7 abstentions.
- 10/19/20-15 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, proposal EP.21.018 was approved as originally presented with 129 in favor, 13 opposed, and 2 abstentions.
- 10/19/20-16 Faculty senator Dallesasse (ENGR) made a motion to postpone the remaining items of business until the November 16, 2020 Senate meeting. The motion was seconded with no discussion.
- 10/19/20-17 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, the motion to postpone remaining business was approved with 130 in favor, 7 opposed, and 1 abstention.

No new business.

IX. ANNUAL MEETING OF THE FACULTY

President Timothy Killeen and Chancellor Robert Jones gave opening remarks before answering questions from attendees.

President Killeen noted that this has been quite a year with all the challenges. Even amid this pandemic, students and families have still made the choice to come to Illinois. This fall there has been a record number of students, 52,000 students, admitted.

The University is making a number of positive efforts to combat the COVID-19 virus. The University of Illinois has attracted attention from around the world because of the SHIELD program and the ability to open the University with a successful hybrid model. The University of Illinois Urbana Champaign has contributed to fighting COVID by providing PPE (personal protective equipment), producing hand sanitizer, and creating the emergency ventilator which is being offered in India for free. The University of Illinois Chicago (UIC) is participating in three of the vaccine trials, and the hospital system is taking care of many underrepresented minorities. The University of Illinois System is upholding its commitment to the land-grant mission, impact for the public good.

The mental health issues we are facing are not trivial and the level of isolation young people are facing is extraordinary and we need to think carefully how to mitigate that. And we also need to be thinking about a post-pandemic style of higher education. Like everything else mentioned, the University of Illinois can lead the way.

The University of Illinois is grateful to have received about \$100 million in federal support from the CARES Act (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security). This helps but did not go far enough to offset the costs the System has incurred, approximately \$400 million and growing. We are optimistic that the next relief act will include significant support for higher education and are heavily advocating for additional federal support.

Killeen is confident the University of Illinois will weather this storm. Alumni are standing in support and the University has raised over \$400 million, a record-breaking number. Employees have not been laid off, nor have furloughs been conducted despite the duress. Our senior leadership is committed to this University.

The University of Illinois is facing three crises, the health crisis, the racial inequity crisis, and the economic crisis. The University of Illinois is strong and committed. Faculty will continue to be recruited and retained, and a recommitment will be made to the diversity of our faculty and undergraduate student body. Our student body has become more diverse over the five years that Killeen and Jones have been leading this University, but there is still more work to do. The University of Illinois is a world leader in education and innovation.

Chancellor Jones thanked the faculty for all the hard work during this difficult time. The work that has been done through shared governance is very important. It has been eight months since the message was sent ending face-to-face instruction. While we have moved quickly in response to COVID-19, every decision has been made to maximize the

safety of our faculty, staff, and students. Decisions are based on science and evidence. We have not allowed a sense of urgency to bypass broad consultation and communication with faculty, staff, and students. Jones noted that he and Provost Cangellaris along with other senior leadership and COVID-19 work teams attended the numerous SEC meetings over the summer. Since March, more than 75 Massmail messages have been sent regarding COVID-19. That is a large number of messages. We continue to honor and utilize our shared governance system in decisions that have been made regarding COVID-19.

The COVID-19 rapid saliva test has garnered world-wide attention. The test is rapid, cost-effective, and has been deployed on a scale that is unmatched in this country. The Safer Illinois app was developed to facilitate test notification and safety and is now used by over 40,000 members of the University community. The testing protocol has allowed the University of Illinois to open and offer classes and a residential experience that others have found very difficult or impossible.

We have figured out our path this semester because we have found ways to effectively face these challenges together. Hopefully with the Senate vote on the academic calendar, we will have a clearer path for the spring semester. Plans are in place to share the spring calendar information with the University community tomorrow morning if the Senate approves the changes to the academic calendar. This message will also include important guidance about safety practices and expectations going into the Thanksgiving break, the final weeks of this semester, and how the return in the spring semester will be handled.

Now is the time to become more vigilant in testing and following safety protocols. There is nothing ordinary or easy about this experience. There is no other University in this country that has navigated this challenge more successfully with more compassion and more creativity than the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign.

The floor was opened to questions.

Faculty senator Rosenstock (LAS) asked Chancellor Jones if an in-person graduation is being planned for the end of the spring semester. Jones stated that no decision has been made at this time whether graduation will be in-person or virtual.

Student senator Fogarty (GRAD) encouraged the Senate to return to the regular agenda so a vote can be taken on the academic calendar.

Faculty senator Kwapil (LAS) asked the Chancellor about the recent aggression by Turkey and Azerbaijan on the sovereign nation of Armenia. Our University has a proud history of training Armenian students and employing Armenian scholars. What steps has the University taken in response to this matter? Chancellor Jones responded that he has only had brief conversations with Provost Cangellaris, but Jones plans to meet with the

International Studies leadership team about this issue and to try to formulate the best course of action to support our members of this University and then discuss the appropriate course of action we can take as a University in the broader context.

Faculty senator Riechers (ACES) asked if there are any metrics or feedback about how the quality of our classes this semester would compare to our peer institutions. Chancellor Jones asked Provost Cangellaris to answer because Cangellaris meets regularly with other provosts in the BigTen Academic Alliance (BTAA). Cangellaris noted that in these BTAA provost meetings, everyone shares experiences and lessons learned. The mental stress of students and faculty during this time is of concern. Students and faculty alike have been overwhelmed by COVID-19 in many ways. Care and compassion need to be the number one priority. Quality without appreciation of the challenges that everyone is facing falls short of addressing the most important thing, the wellbeing of everyone.

The Senate returned to the agenda and resumed discussion on EP.21.018 (10/19/20-11).

X. ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned at 5:15 pm.
