SP.21.03 Revision to the *Bylaws*, Part D.20 – Committee on University Student Life

## **BACKGROUND**

Responding to the Report of the Eighth Senate Review Commission (XSR.19.01), the Senate Committee on University Student Life (SL) examined its charge and composition as provided in the *Bylaws*, Part D.20 and recommends the following revisions.

The proposed changes would specify a seat on SL for an international student and identify *ex officio* seats for the Dean of the Graduate College, the Vice Chancellor for Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, and the Director of International Student and Scholar Services.

## RECOMMENDATION

The Senate Committee on University Statutes and Senate Procedures recommends the approval of the following revisions to the *Bylaws*. Text to be deleted is struck through and text to be added is underlined. Adoption of amendments to the *Bylaws* requires a two-thirds vote of the Senate.
