EP.22.143 Update to the 2022-2023 Academic Calendar to Include General Election Day as a Holiday

BACKGROUND

This proposal adds the General Election Day of Tuesday, November 8, 2022 as a holiday to the 2022-2023 Academic Calendar.

This update is in accordance with the Election Code:

  (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2023)
  Sec. 2A-1.1c. 2022 Election Day State holiday. Notwithstanding any other
provision of State law to the contrary, November 8, 2022 shall be a State
holiday known as 2022 General Election Day and shall be observed throughout
the State. November 8, 2022 shall be deemed a legal school holiday for
purposes of the School Code and State Universities Civil Service Act. Any
school closed under this amendatory Act of the 102nd General Assembly and
Section 24-2 of the School Code shall be made available to an election
authority as a polling place for 2022 General Election Day.
   This Section is repealed on January 1, 2023.
