SC.27.02 Election of an Undergraduate Student Senator to the 2026-2027 Committee on Committees

**BACKGROUND**

The Senate Committee on Committees (CC) includes student representation as outlined in Part D.6.b of the Senate *Bylaws*. Two student senators, one undergraduate and one graduate or professional student, serve on the committee. Additionally, a designated seat is held by the Deputy Speaker of the Illinois Student Council or the Deputy's designee.

Nominations for the CC shall be made by the incumbent Senate Executive Committee (SEC). Nominations may also be made for student committee positions by student senators. Each nomination shall be accompanied by the consent of the nominee. Nominees must be student senators at the time the committee term begins. (*Bylaws* Part D.6.c.1)

**NOMINATIONS**

The Senate Executive Committee (SEC) nominates the following student senator to serve a one-year term ending **2027** on the Senate Committee on Committees.

Each senator may vote for up to **one undergraduate student senator nominee**. Cumulative voting is not permitted. The nominee with the highest number of votes will be declared elected.
