Proposal to Rename the World Heritage Museum

JUSTIFICATION

This is a proposal to change the name of the World Heritage Museum to the Spurlock Museum. The name change will parallel that of our new facility made possible through the donations of the Spurlock Family. The Spurlock Museum facility offers new flexibility in collection acquisition, programs for outreach and continuing education as well as on-campus learning facilities. These new programs could not be adequately addressed under our old rubric (as well as our quarters in Lincoln Hall). To separate our new direction and programs from our previous offerings, we think it necessary to be viewed as a new entity--one in line with the vision we portrayed to the University administration and to the Spurlock heirs.
